Mental Health/Cancer/Peer Support Study Seeking Participants

Have you experienced a **cancer** diagnosis, or supported someone through their cancer diagnosis and treatment as a **peer supporter**? If so, you might be someone we'd like to hear from.

I'm working with some colleagues to learn about how people who've been involved in the **behavioral** health system are treated by medical providers, how they get useful information about cancer, and how they get emotional support. The project has been approved by the Institutional Review Board which is responsible for human subjects research at The University of Arizona, and the actual survey is completely anonymous. Through the generous support of the New York State Office of Mental Health, APS offers over 70 online self-paced courses, 13 of which are approved for the initial application to attain a New York Certified Peer Specialist (NY-CPS) certification. All of our courses are approved by the New York Peer Specialist Certification Board (NYPSCB) for continuing education on current topics related to peer support services and supervision. APS is free of charge and open to anyone who has an interest in learning about peer support services.
