Advisory Council Member

A NYS Trauma-Informed Network Advisory Council Member plays a critical role in the establishment and growth of the network by:

- Attending and meaningfully participating in the bi-monthly Advisory Council virtual meetings
- Attending and meaningfully participating in the Annual in-person meeting
- Contributing the development of Network Quarterly Meeting agendas and content
- Assuring high quality, diverse content in the site by posting resources, events, and registering in the Directory
- Providing guidance and feedback to the CCSI Project Lead
- Sharing expertise and insight through BLOG authorship and/or Newsletter contributions
- Periodically checking the site's Discussion Forums, posting as needed to provide guidance and role modelling
